- Verse 1-2 Because of the Gospel we are to give ourselves to God, being transformed by Him and not conforming to the world.
- Verses 3-8 God's Grace has brought us together as a family, as a unit, such as a church body. Each person has an important function and uses these gifts as God gives them and strengthens us to use them.

- 2. Like glue super glue

5. Show Honor

- 1. Leading others to show honor.
- 2. Romans 12:3
- 3. Philippians 2:3

2. Serving Love (11)

- 1. Purpose Life
 - 1. Zeal
 - 2. Pursuing God is daily living.
 - 3. Not lazy in Spiritual Life.

2. Passionate

- 1. Fervent = to boil.
- 2. Passion of spirit from the Spirit.
- 3. Passion to love and serve.

3. Serve God

- 1. 1 Corinthians 10:31 Glorify God
- 2. Serving should be done with passion.
- 3. 1 Peter 4:11 Serve from the strength and passion that God gives.

3. Devoted Love (12)

- 1. Rejoice in Hope
 - 1. Rejoicing "cheerful Calmly Happy
 - 2. Hope a certain event but not knowing the time.

2. Patient in Trials

- 1. Pressure Affliction Persecution
- 2. Our joy in Hope keeps us patient in trials.
- 3. James 1:2 Count it all joy.

3. Constant in Prayer

- 1. Earnest Prayer.
- 2. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18
- 3. Part of prayer is Worship.
- 4. So as we are devoted to worship/prayer, we can rejoice and persevere in trials.

4. Sharing Love (13)

1. Share Needs

- 1. Partners Fellowship
- 2. Make someone else's needs yours and help them.

2. Seek to show Hospitality

- 1. Pursue Follow To run swiftly after someone To seek eagerly.
- 2. To Love Strangers.
- 3. This does not speak to a "Hospitality Team" Rather a command for all believers. Hospitality in this since looks like sharing a meal together, loving strangers.
