1. THE CHURCH'S MEANING (v.14-15)
The church consists of those who are a part of God's family, in other words,
those who are His
His children are those who have been connected to!
(John 14:6)
Paul is writing this letter so that God's children know how to live their lives
and because they are God's children, they must live their lives by His!
God is not dead, or some idol made by human hands, He is alive and working
in and through us! He in us and with us.
(2 Corinthians 6:16)
We are His people because He bought us at a high price, and we belong to
Him to His purposes and plans for us!
(1 Corinthians 6:20)
2. THE CHURCH'S MISSION (v.15)
In this analogy, Paul is making it clear that the church's primary responsibility
is to uphold the truth of God's
The church's mission is to glorify God by the truth,

God's Word lasts! (Isaiah 40:8; 1 Peter 1:23-25)

3. THE CHURCH'S MESSAGE (v.16)
The primary message the church is to share is the, the
good news of what Jesus has done for us! It's all about Jesus!
Key components of the gospel message and its effectiveness:
1) Jesus was fully and fully and died for our sins.
(John 1:1;14)
2) Jesus was by the power of the Holy Spirit.
(Romans 1:4; Romans 8:11)
3) The angels testify to Jesus'
(Hebrews 1:6)
<b>4)</b> After His resurrection Jesus into Heaven and is reigning as
King of kings and Lord of lords!
(Acts 1:9-10; Hebrews 1:3)
5) The message about Jesus is to be in all the world!
(Matthew 28:18-20)
<b>6)</b> Those who in Jesus will be saved!

(Romans 10:9; Romans 10:14)
