2. The _____ of Jesus (v.23)

In order to save us from our sins and bring us into a right relationship with God, Jesus had to pay the _____ for sin, which was His death.

We are _____ in our sin. We are by nature, just by being born, God's enemies! (**Ephesians 2:1-4**)

We must all realize that it was my sin and your sin that caused Jesus to have to die. So, Peter's words are true for us as well – we _____ Jesus. He died for our sins. (**2 Corinthians 5:21**)

Jesus' death was a part of God's _____ all along! (**John 3:16**)

3. The _____ of Jesus (v.24-32)

The greatest _____ that Jesus is who He said He was, is His resurrection!

4. The _____ of Jesus (v.33-36)

After His resurrection, Jesus _____ into Heaven where He reigns as King of kings and Lord of lords!
